Abe's to supply bagel crisps to Woolies

Auckland company Abe's has won a contract to supply New Zealand-made bagel crisps to 700 Woolworths Australia stores.

Owners Megan Sargent and Brent Milburn told The New Zealand Herald it had taken them 18 months, four trips across the Tasman and plenty of tinkering with the product to seal the Australian deal.

Their bagel factory would need to be extended, and ten extra staff hired taking the total number of workers to about 50.

Abe's bagel crisps are due to be on supermarket shelves in Australia from next month.
